Minimum Standard for Passing E.M.T.-1

YOU MUST:

1. Maintain 80% on every Quiz. (30 % of Final grade)
2. Pass Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation CPR/AED Skills.
CPR is the MANDATORY BASIC skill of the EMT-1
3. Pass the course Written Final Exam with a minimum of 80%. (30 % of Final grade)
4. Pass the E.M.T. Skills Proficiency Exam. (Pass/Fail Exam) (40 % of Final grade)
5. Do two (2) ten (10) hour “Clinical Experiences” with five (5) patient contacts.
 - a.) Field unit (Ambulance, Engine or Squad)
 - b.) Hospital Emergency RoomWritten Report for each clinical experience is required. (Notebook)
Mandatory per Title 22; Division 9 of the California Health & Safety Code
6. Not miss more than ten (10) % of the class time. (nineteen (19) hours)
If you do... you will be dropped. Required by Health & Safety Code.
7. Take ALL Quizzes. If absent on a quiz, make up tests are considered a re-take. See 9.
8. **NOT CHEAT!!!** If you do.... You will be dropped or failed. (College Policy)
9. Re-take Quizzes. If you score below 80% on a quiz or are absent you are allowed one (1) re-take of **that** quiz. You are allowed re-takes on **two (2) quizzes ONLY**.
YOU MUST SCORE A MINIMUM OF 85% ON A RE-TAKE QUIZ.
10. Be 18 (eighteen) years of age and **not** be precluded from certification by Health & Safety Code 1798.200. DOJ background check with “Live Scan” fingerprinting and drug testing is **REQUIRED**.
