



Skills Standards for Passing E.M.T.-1

Final Skills Test:

You will be given three (3) attempts to pass each skill. If you fail the skill you will be instructed in what you did wrong. You will be given time to practice and remediate after each attempt. You will be evaluated by a different evaluator on your second attempt. On your third attempt you will be evaluated by two different evaluators. If you fail the third attempt you will fail the skill and thus fail EMT.

The standard is:

1. Do we (the evaluators) want you working on our family members.
2. Would we (the evaluators) want you on our EMS team.
3. No critical error omissions or commissions.
4. Must attain minimum number of points to pass.

Final Skills Exams:

1. Patient Assessment (Medical)
2. Patient Assessment (Trauma)
3. Upper Airway Adjuncts and Suction
4. Bag-Valve-Mask (Apneic Patient)
5. Supplemental Oxygen Administration
6. Mouth-to-Mouth with Supplemental Oxygen
7. Cardiac Arrest Management / AED
8. Bleeding Control and Shock Management
9. Spinal Immobilization Supine Patient
10. Spinal Immobilization Seated Patient
11. Unattached Avulsion or Amputation
12. Long Bone Immobilization
13. Joint/Dislocation Injury
14. Traction Splinting
15. Prehospital Childbirth
