ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR E.M.T.-1 STUDENTS

Hospital clinical time is a **requirement** for EMT-1 training.
(Division 9 Title XXII of the Health & Safety Code)

The Joint Commission for Accreditation of Healthcare Organizations (JCAHO) **require:**

1. Background check (DMV, Criminal, Social Security and Office of Inspector General review)
2. Drug screening (Nine panel drug screen)
 - a. Amphetamines
 - b. Barbiturates
 - c. Benzodiazepines
 - d. Cocaine
 - e. Marijuana
 - f. Opiates
 - g. PCP
 - h. Propoxyphenes
 - i. Methadone
3. Physical exam
4. TB screening
5. Valid CPR certification

In order to participate in this class you (the student) **must:**

1. Register with and submit to the drug test at a LabCorp. Site.
2. Submit to a background check. (VerifyStudents.com \$106.00)
3. Sign a consent form for “random” drug testing.
4. Have current CPR certification.
5. Complete the Physical Exam at the Rio Hondo Health Center. (\$20.00)
